 - i. VCSU Volleyball lost two games this past weekend against Dickinson (25th) and Jamestown (26th). The girls dropped a 5 set match against Dickinson and a 3 set match against Jamestown. Volleyball travels to Mayville tomorrow (29th) for a conference match at 7pm and travels to Clarke this weekend to play 4 games.
 - ii. Viking football lost this weekend as they traveled to Dickinson on Saturday losing by a score of 7-28 with a record of 1:1 in conference play now. Football plays on October 3rd at 2:00pm in Valley City against Mayville.
 - iii. Baseball also traveled to Jamestown on Wednesday (23rd) and Dickinson this past Sunday (27th). VCSU lost against Jamestown 7-12 and lost the doubleheader against Dickinson 3-9 and 0-2. Baseball will play Mayville on Wednesday (30th) at 6pm in Valley City.
 - iv. Softball had games this past weekend as well and ended the weekend with a 4 and 2 record.

- v. Cross Country was at the University of Minnesota this past weekend and ended with success. For the women Alexandra Cardenas placed 149th out of 360 runners with a time of 26:00.5. Jenna Coghlan finished 292nd with a time of 28:31.2 and Geneva Espinoza finished 345th with a time of 32:01.4. For the men, Misael Herrera finished the 8K race with a time of 29:41.3 placing him 226th out of 392. Orrin Rambow placed 316th with a time of 31:31.7 and Alex Askerooth placed 362nd with a time of 33:39.2. Next competition is on October 9th at the Jimmie invitational in Jamestown.
- vi. On Thursday (24th) men's Golf finished 1st overall at the Cougar invitational with Jared Lentz leading the team and tying individually for first place shooting and even par game of 71. Kyle Wiebe shot 72 and placed 4th. Ben Sorenson shot 75, Tyler Baukol and Tyler Stevens shot a 79 and Dean Schroeder competed individually and shot a 78. For the women Nicole Heinitz shot a 97 and placed 5th individually and Nicole Mosiman shot a 102 and placed 7th. Mara Nysetvold placed 18th and Hannah Gress placed 25th and overall VCSU placed 5th/6 teams. Next they compete in the qualifying tournament September 28th-29th in Oxbow ND.
