 - i. Last Wednesday softball played Jamestown University, and split with them 6-3 and 4-6. Friday and Saturday softball played Waldorf and went 3-1 out of their four games. The girls play Tuesday against Jamestown starting at 3:00pm at home. This weekend they will play Dakota State in Madison SD starting 1:00pm Saturday and Sunday.
 - ii. Baseball played North Dakota State and lost 5-6. They took on Jamestown this weekend playing 4 games going 0-3 with one game being called due to rain and lightning. This Tuesday they will be travelling to Winnipeg at 2:00pm. This weekend they will play at home against Dickinson starting at 2:00pm on Saturday and noon on Sunday.
 - iii. Track and Field competed in Aberdeen SD this past weekend as well. They came back with a new school record and top throw in the North Star and the entire NAIA by Seri Geisler in javelin. She beat second place by 39 ft, topped her own record by 5m and topped the NAIA leader since 2014 by almost 4m. Seri also

placed first in shot put. Additional top 5 finishes include Kaitlin Connor taking 3rd in long jump and 4th in triple jump. Malik Jackson took 3rd in 400, Lenzel Koskela taking 5th in 400, Dillion Thomas taking 3rd in 110m hurdles, Niklas Ernst taking 2th in 400m hurdles, Alex Askerooth took 5th in the 3,000m steeplechase, the men's 4x400 relay team took 3rd place, Marcos Zavaleta took 3rd in pole vault, Ellwood Ellenson took 5th in triple jump and Jacob Peterson took 4th in javelin. Next they will compete on the 30th in Jamestown.
