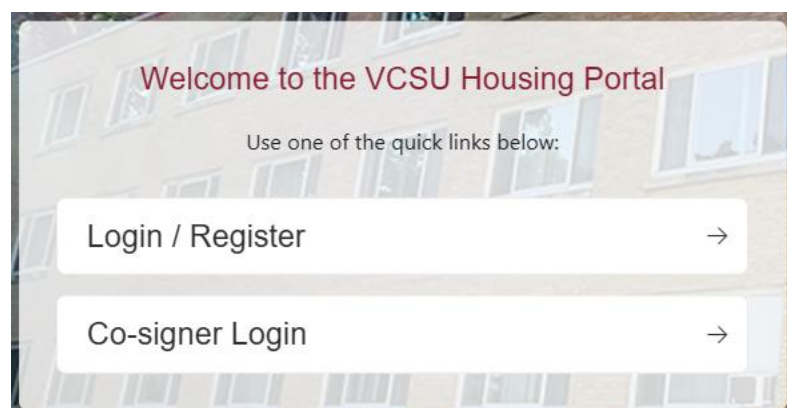

Note: This is not the final deadline to apply, just when we recommend applying before in order to get your housing assignment information as soon as possible.

Have These Ready Before You Start:

- Your [NDUS EMPLID](#) (Student ID Number)
- Your NDUS Username and Password (found by claiming your [Campus Connection Account](#))
- Information for at least one emergency contact and missing persons contact (name, address, phone number, email, etc. – these can be the same person)
- Name of your roommate or suitemate preferences (if applicable)
- A credit or debit card to pay the \$50 room reservation fee.

STEP 1: LOG IN

What To Do

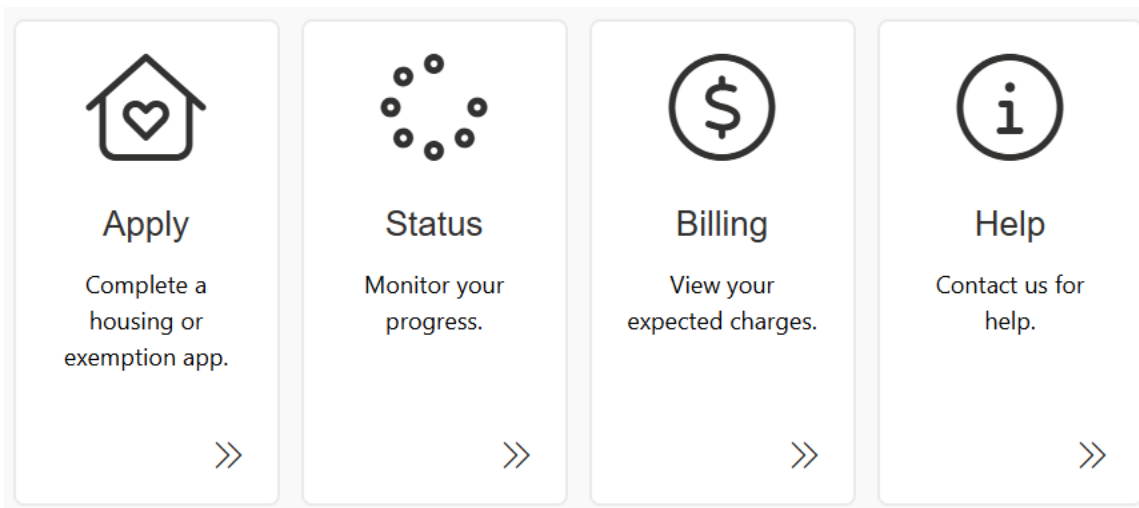
1. Enter information for at least one emergency contact by choosing the red **Emergency Contact 1 Address** and then scrolling down to click the "Change" button. Don't forget to press "Save."
2. Go back to the main page by clicking "Home" on the top main navigation bar.
3. Enter information for at least one missing person contact by choosing the red **Missing Person 1 Address** and then scrolling down to click the "Change" button. Don't forget to press "Save."
4. Go back to the main page by clicking "Home" on the top main navigation bar.
 - *Make sure each contact's name, relationship, phone number, email address, and mailing address are correct.*
 - *If your emergency contact and missing person contact are the same person, you may enter the same information in both sections.*
5. When you have completed the required contact information, you will be automatically redirected to the home page.

Why This Matters

This information helps VCSU know who to contact in an emergency or if there is a concern about your safety. Your emergency contact is the person the university may reach out to in urgent situations. Your missing person contact is the person you choose to be contacted if you are reported missing.

These can be the same person, but both sections need to be completed so we have the right information on file.

STEP 2: START YOUR HOUSING APPLICATION



What To Do

1. Click “Apply”
2. Choose the correct period of time that you would like to live on campus
3. Choose whether you are a first-year, transfer, or returning student
