he W.E. Osmon Fieldhouse was built in 1960 and has remained largely the same. Over the last 60 years, Viking Athletics has outgrown the facility. Our athletes have increased from 111 to nearly 300 and more than 20 athletic staff have been added. Women's athletics has been added and teams on campus have doubled.
